### FATALITY ACCIDENT – 07-04-2007 – CULVER & STATE HWY 50

On 07-04-2007 around 1:03am, emergency crews were dispatched to a major motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Culver and State Highway 50 in Commerce.

Commerce Police officers found that two vehicles were involved in the accident; a 1998 white Ford Mustang and a 2005 red extended cab Ford Ranger.

Witnesses told police that the Ford Mustang was eastbound on Loop 178, crossing over State Hwy 50 and the Ford Ranger was Northbound on State Hwy 50. The Ford Mustang failed to stop at a red light and was struck by the Ford Ranger.

The Mustang was driven by Sasha Cherie Mundrake, 17 years of age of Lone Oak. There were two passengers, identified as Chelse Haight, 17, of Grandbury and Taylor Hager, 18 of Quinlan. Mundrake and Chelse were airlifted to Parkland Hospital . Hager was pronounced dead at the scene by Justice of the Peace Jennifer Reeves.

The Ford Ranger was driven by Isaac Bullard, 26 years old of Seagoville, TX . He was not injured.

Alcohol is suspected as being a factor in this accident. In a fatality accident, it is mandatory that all drivers submit to a blood alcohol test. It could be several weeks before the results are know.
